Time of the Award Ceremony: 4pm (to be confirmed)

Concept:

Every teacher selects one work of art for every subscribed class. The Jury will chose a winner in each category. The winners will be presented with their prizes at the Bonjour Perth Festival. Parents and a representative of the winner's school will be invited to be present at the ceremony.

Objective:

To give the students studying French the opportunity to participate in a project where they can discover the Francophone culture and extend their vocabulary.

Course of the events before the Festival:

Registration:

Free to participate. The teacher has to register his/her school before **the 20th of August 2016**. Schools interested in participating are required to submit the registration form **via email**.

Creation of works of art:

According to the students' levels (see the conditions of the competition below), a work of art should be created by one student.

Selection and submission:

The teacher will select **ONE WORK of ART** in every registered class and send the selected pieces before **the 20th of September 2016** to TOFA via mail or deliver it in person. **TOFA is able to reimburse postage costs upon request.**

Every piece of art needs to have a label at the back stating the student(s), name(s), year level year level, name of the school and the name and contact phone (or email) of the teacher.

Please note that the Festival team is unable to take responsibility for any damage or loss of work of art.



Competition:

High School Competition:

(Year 7-12): Students write a definition of the word “**Francophonie**” the definition can be illustrated with a drawing.

Important: The definition has to be written on an original material such as wood. **A4 papers are not permitted.**

Primary School Competition:

Students write a definition of the word “**Francophonie**” or draw a picture to illustrate the word “**Francophonie**”.

The definition or the drawing has to be written/drawn on an original material such as wood. **A4 papers are not permitted.**

Prize

Prizes for the student/school participants are provided by The Teachers of French Association (TOFA) and will be presented at the Prize Giving Ceremony at the Bonjour Perth Festival on **22th of October.**

1st Prize: \$80.00 Itune Voucher

2nd Prize: \$50.00 Itune Voucher

3rd Prize: \$30.00 Itune Voucher

Display of Artwork:

All the works of art will be on display during the Festival.

The pieces displayed during the Festival are to be recuperated between **4 and 5 pm on the day of the event.**
